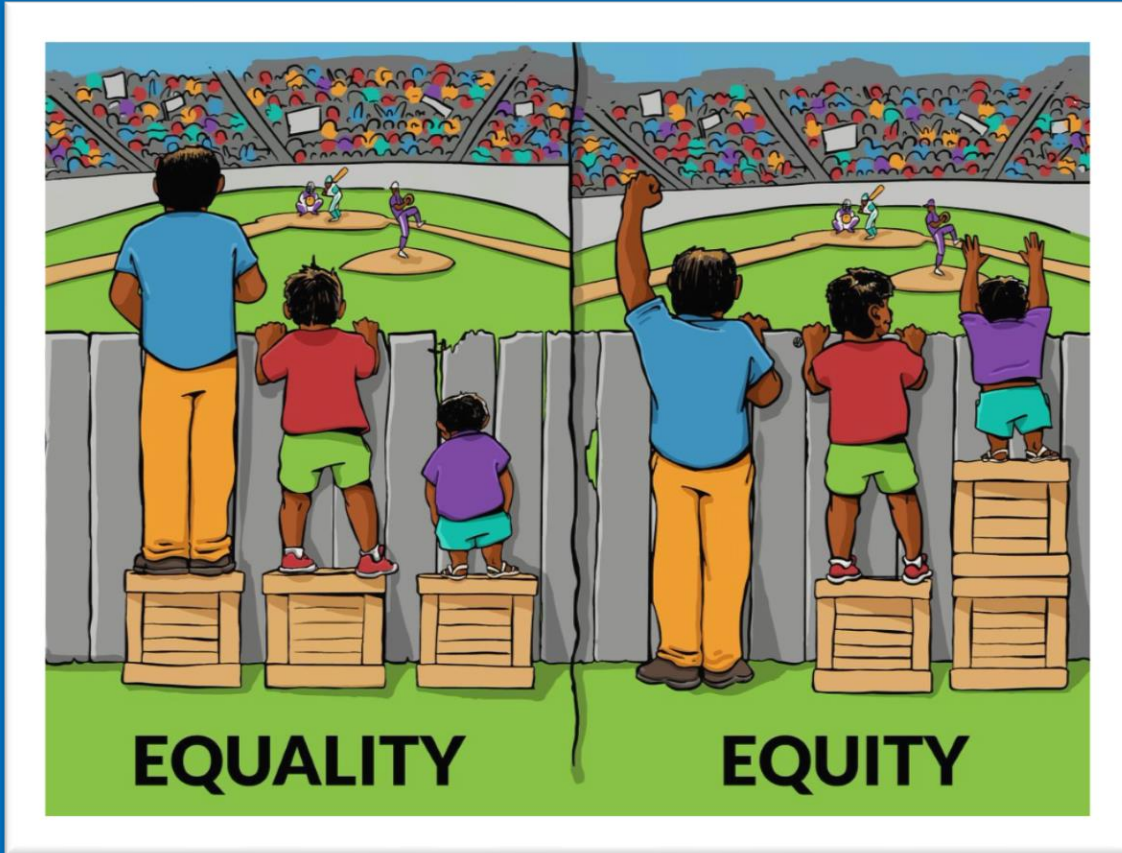
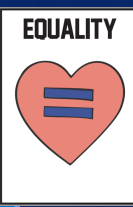
# October Value: Equality

# Southwark Value: Equality



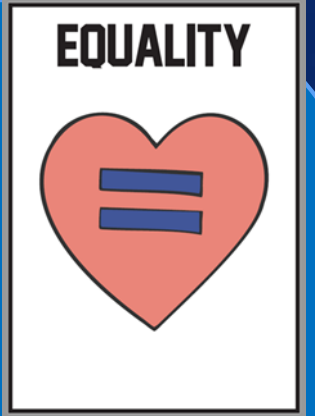
**Equity** is giving everyone what they need to be successful. **Equality** is treating everyone the same.

*Nothing should hold you back or prevent you from achieving your goals.*



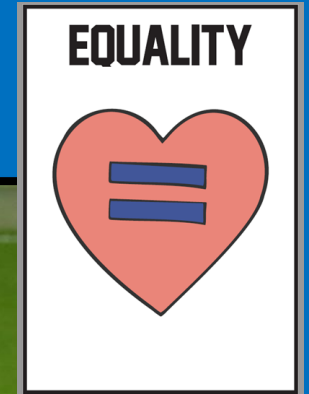
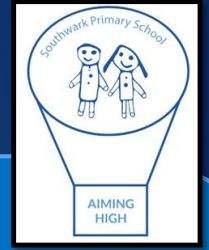
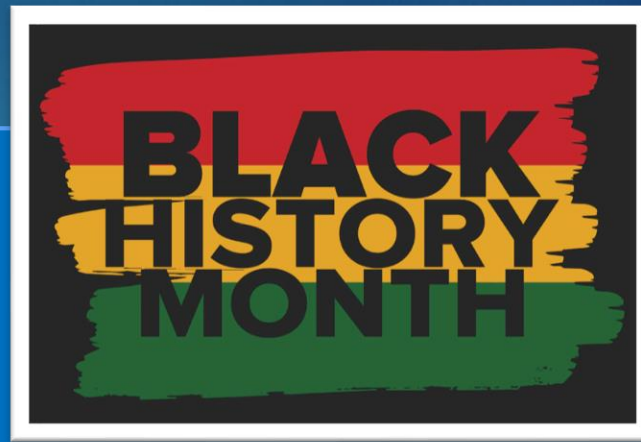

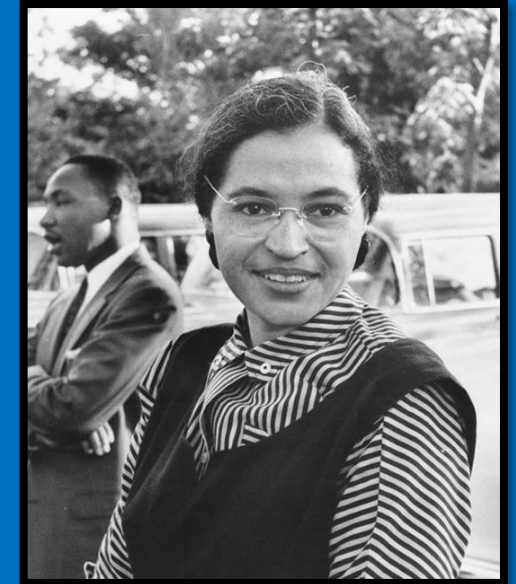
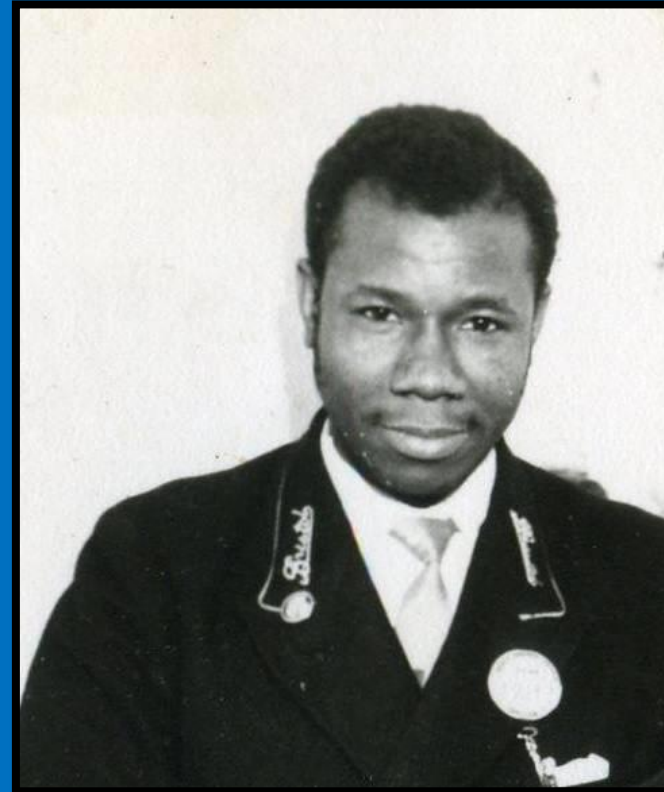
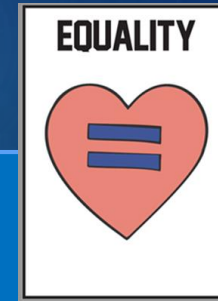
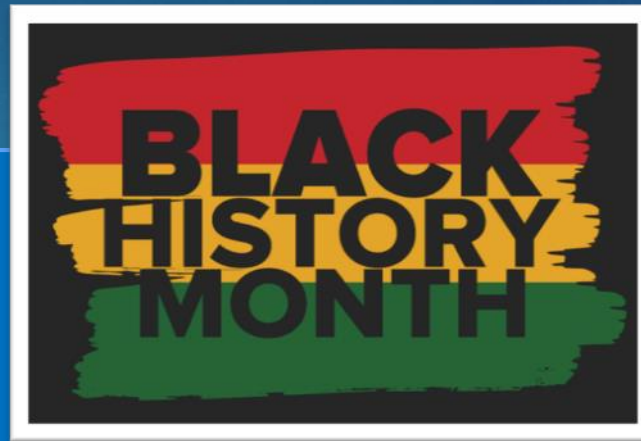
## Southwark Value: Equality

Here is *Norman Samuels*.

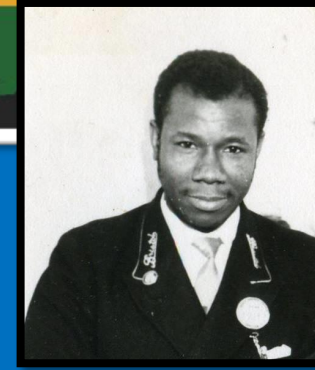

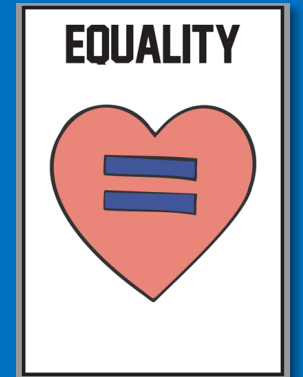
## Southwark Value: Equality

Norman Samuels was the first black bus driver in Bristol after the 1963 bus boycott in Bristol led to the bus company changing its racist policies that stopped black people from working on the buses. After the boycott, the 1965 Race Relations Act banned all discrimination in the workplace in the UK.



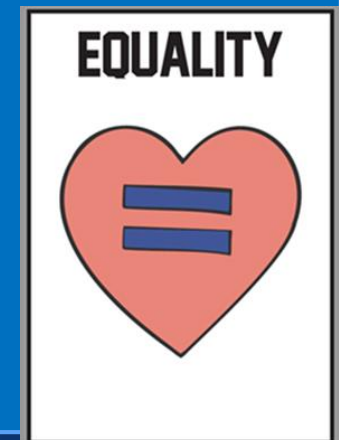
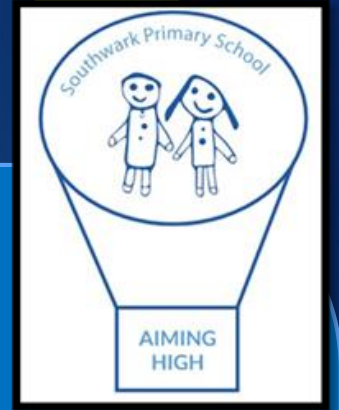
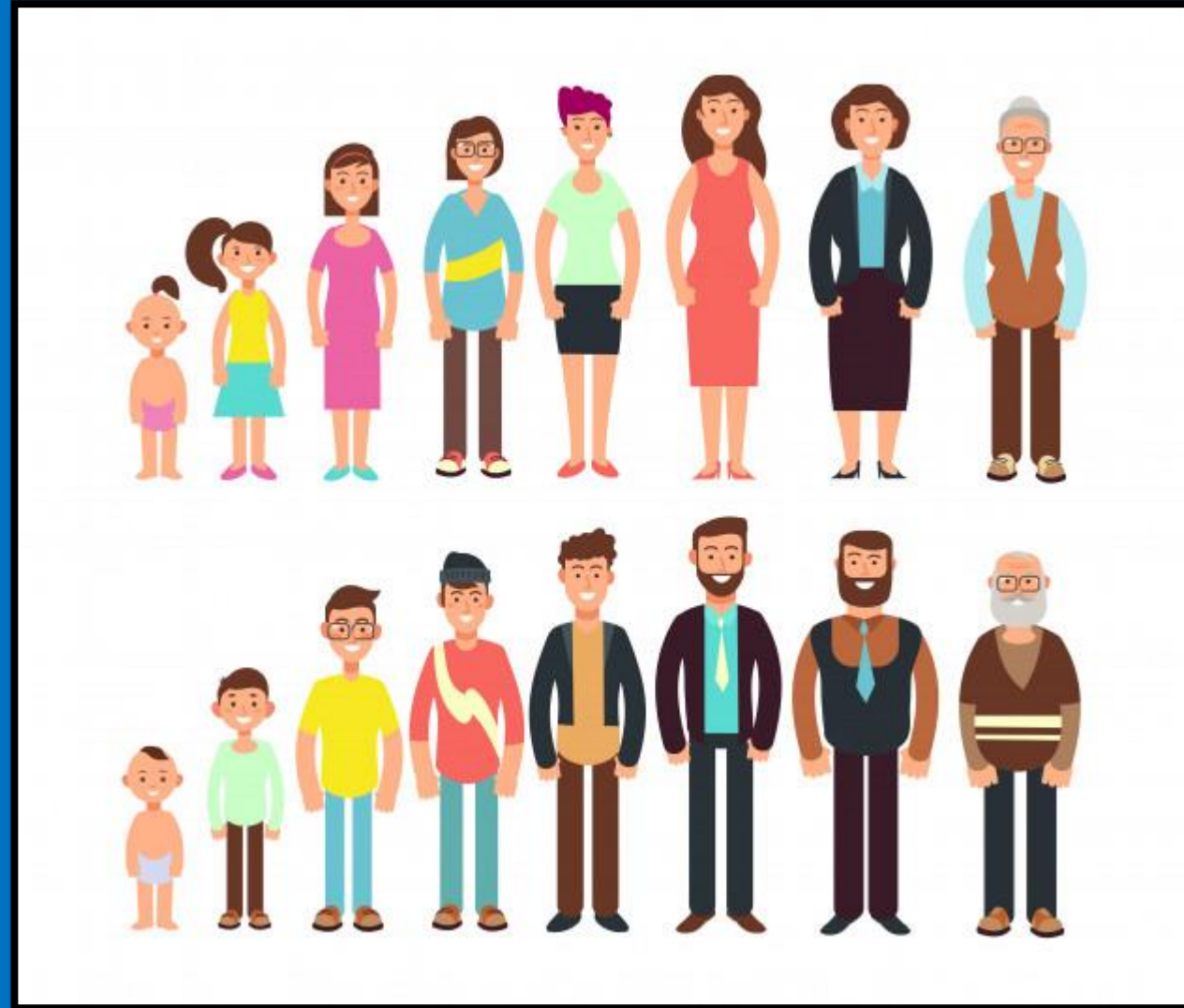
# Southwark Value: Equality

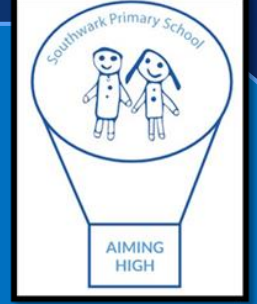

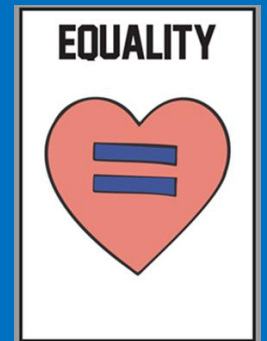
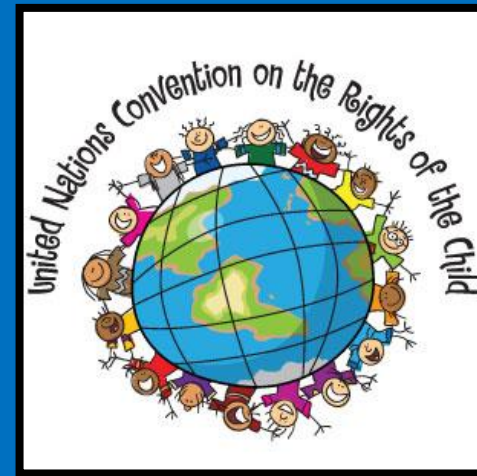
- Life, survival and development*
